Ridgetop Group to Develop an Innovative Troubleshooting and Repair System for Air Force Electronic Warfare Systems

TUCSON, Ariz. — September 4, 2012

Ridgetop Group, Inc. announced that it was awarded a contract by the U.S. Air Force Warner Robins Air Logistics Center (WR-ALC) for the development of an "Expert Troubleshooting and Repair System for Electronic Warfare (EW)." This contract was awarded under a Phase II Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) program, and extends over a two-year performance period.

Ridgetop's innovation will support troubleshooting and provide recommended repair actions for EW equipment at maintenance depots. This troubleshooting system will help reduce costly "could not duplicate" (CND) repair problems, a reduction in mean-time-to-repair (MTTR) rates, and an increase in mean time-betweenmaintenance events (MTBME). This proactive maintenance will translate into reliability increases and cost savings for the Air Force maintenance depots. Sonia Vohnout, Director of Ridgetop's Advanced Diagnostics & Prognostics Division, said "Ridgetop Group is pleased to receive this contract, which is based on the success of our Phase I performance and builds on our prior experience in addressing complex product support issues. Our advanced troubleshooting system provides, for each service/shop replaceable unit (SRU), a prioritized list of maintenance tests and repair actions that is based on historical maintenance data, and will provide substantial savings in maintenance."
