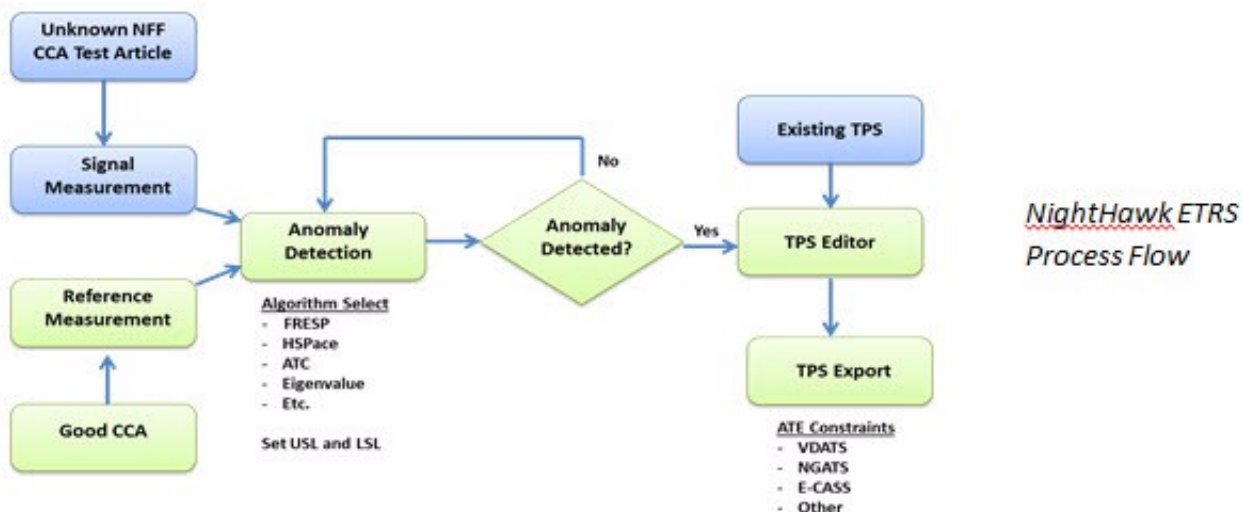


Ridgetop Group, Inc. NightHawk Recognized for Advanced Fault Isolation Algorithms at CTMA
